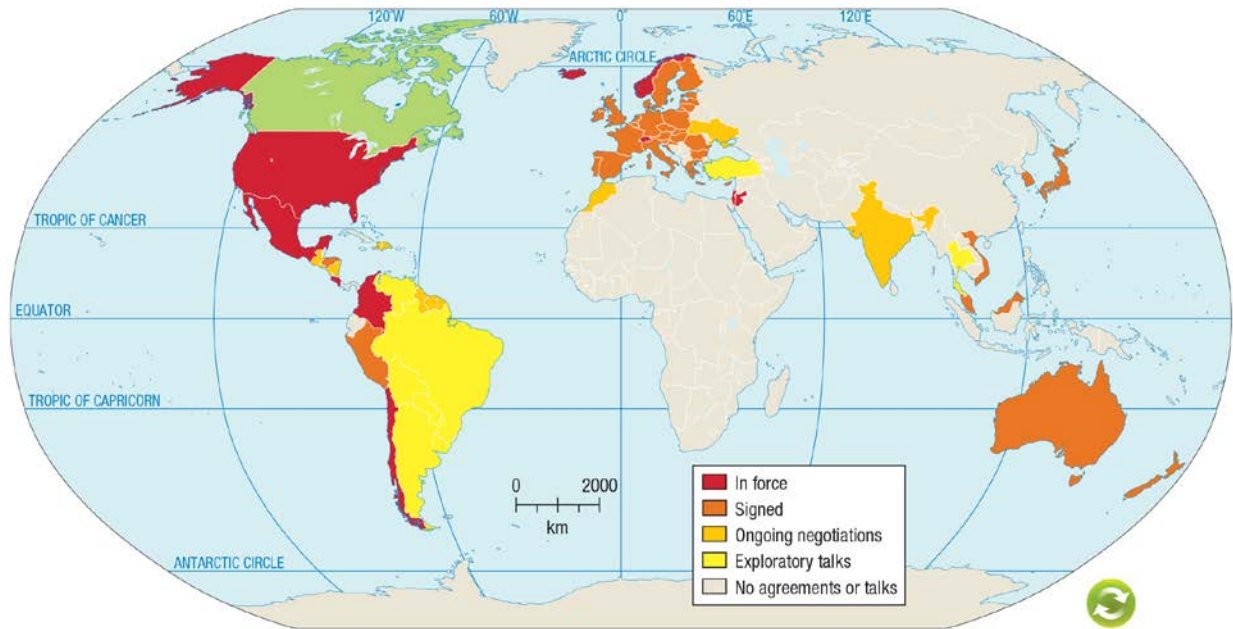

Caption: Figure 8-15 **Canada’s current and future trade partners**. What countries with large economies are not Canada’s current or potential free trade partners? Note that some countries such as the United States and Mexico are members of more than one free trade agreement.

The last sentence in the second bullet should now read: “By far the most important of these are the North American Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA, in place since 1994), and the Canada-European Union Comprehensive Economic and Trade Agreement (CETA), and Trans-Pacific Partnership (TPP). Both of these have been signed, but by 2016 were not yet in force.
