Updated question a)

Calculate an index value for each sector for each region/province (18 in all). Express your answer to two decimal places. (Note: The all sectors value for the region/province is always the denominator in the calculation.) For example, Atlantic Canada has 7.8 percent of Canada’s primary workers, but only 6.1% of all workers. The index value is then $7.8 \div 6.1 \approx 1.28$. Record your index values in a table.
